







OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORIES OF CLAIMANTS





NUMBER OF UI RECIPIENTS



- Recipients represent the number of persons receiving at least one UI benefit payment during the month.
- The number of UI recipients decreased to 18,634 in August from 19,953 in July, 2018 and 21,204 in August of 2017.

DURATION OF UI BENEFITS 12 MONTH AVG.



- The maximum duration of UI benefits for most UI claimants is 26 weeks.
- The average duration of UI benefits decreased for the third consecutive month to 12.9 weeks in August from 13.1 weeks in July.
