

PROFILE OF IOWA'S UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

(UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT RECIPIENTS)







OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORIES OF CLAIMANTS



- Recipients represent the number of persons receiving at least one UI benefit payment during the month.
- The number of UI recipients increased in July to 19,953 primarily due to temporary layoffs in the manufacturing sector over holiday week.

DURATION OF UI BENEFITS



- The maximum duration of UI benefits for most UI claimants is 26 weeks.
- The average duration of UI benefits decreased to 13.1 weeks in July from 13.3 weeks in June.
