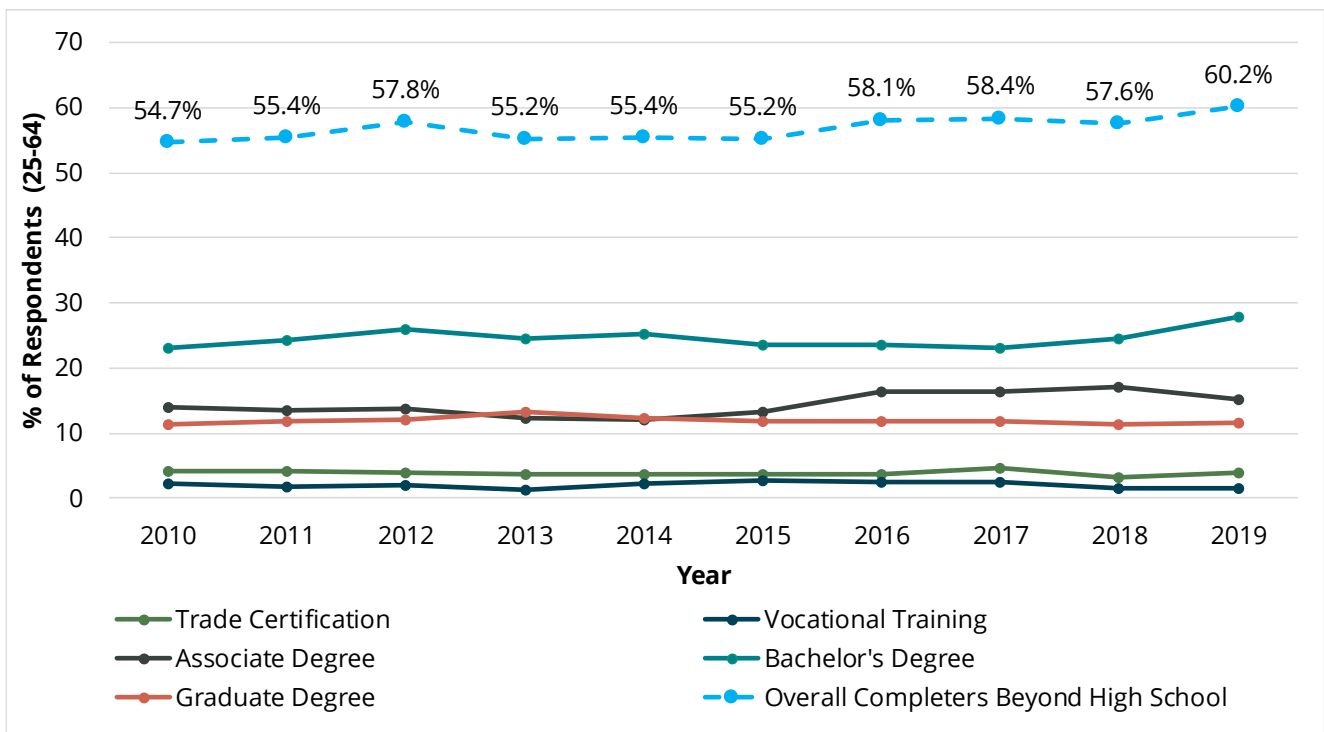

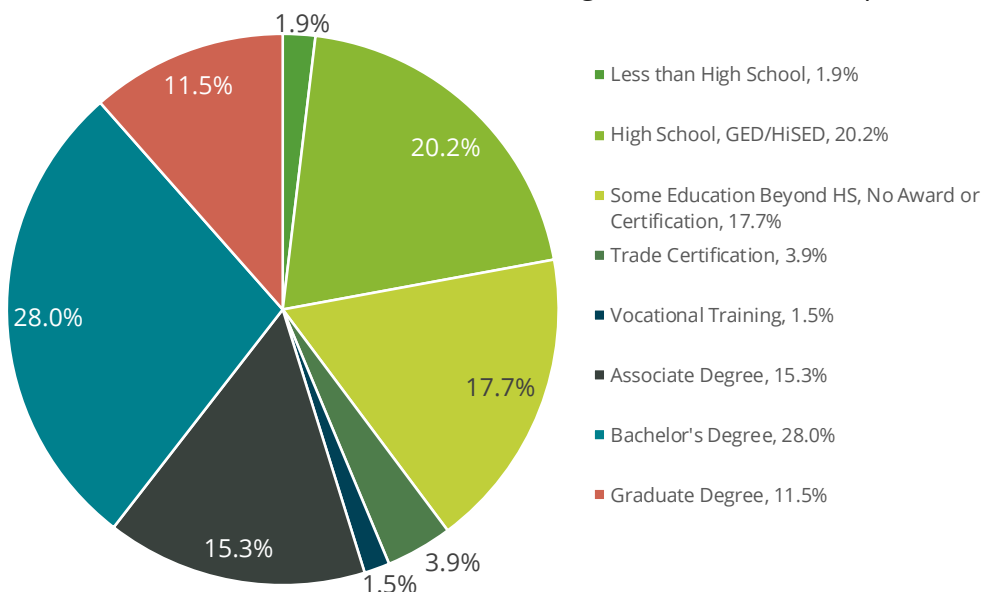

The educational attainment data reported in this publication is for those between 25 and 64 years of age in order to allow time for higher education/training awards, degrees, and certifications to be earned. The percentages reported in the pie chart to the left are based upon answers given by 5,414 Iowa residents.
