Hiring Utilizing E-Verify and Maintaining I-9 Compliance

STORM LAKE, IOWA – IowaWORKS, in conjunction with the Employers' Council of Iowa-Storm Lake Chapter, will be hosting a meeting on Thursday, Feb. 23, 2012 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at Storm Lake United in the conference room, located at 119 W. 6th Street in Storm Lake. All employers, human resource personnel, accounting, payroll and other staff members are invited to attend. Featured speaker(s) will be from U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, Department of Homeland Security.

Now is the ideal time to learn more about E-Verify and the federal employment eligibility verification processes. E-Verify is a fast, free, and easy to use internet-based service run by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Social Security Administration that allows employers to verify the eligibility of their newly hired employees to legally work in the United States.

All employers are already required to complete and retain a Form I-9 - the "Employment Eligibility Verification" form - for each person they hire in the United States. That includes citizens and non-citizens. E-Verify takes the Form I-9 process one step further. It compares information entered on a Form I-9 against information in government records. In most cases, E-Verify informs the employer in just seconds if an employee is eligible to work in the United States. E-Verify isn't a database, but simply a secure way for employers to check new employee's employment eligibility information against existing Social Security Administration and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) records.

The E-Verify web interface recently underwent a major redesign making the system even easier to use. E-Verify customer service was highly rated in the American Customer Satisfaction Index. Visit the E-Verify website to learn more at: www.dhs.gov/E-Verify.
