

### Advantages to Employment

- "What if I earn too much for FIP?" You may still qualify for:
- Child Care Assistance
- Medicaid including transitional Medicaid for those who lose eligibility due to earnings
- Food Assistance
- Earned Income Tax Credit
- Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)

## Other support you may qualify for:

#### Childcare

- Pay childcare while in PROMISE JOBS activities
- Childcare provider must be approved by HHS
- Paid directly to the provider





### Transportation

- For PROMISE JOBS activities (other than employment)
- Program milage rate or public transportation rates
- Put on your Electronic Access Card (EAC), direct deposited into your bank account or paper warrant (if required)

#### **Approved Short-Term Training**

- School application fees
- Tuition
- License, certification & testing fees
- Certain practicum expenses
- Required uniforms & supplies



### A Grant Opportunity for you!

- Family Self- Sufficiency Grant is available to help your family address challenges to obtaining employment
- You could receive up to \$1000 per household!
- Must be on FIP and work ready to be eligible.

### **PROMISE JOBS Customer?**



#### You May Be Eligible to Receive Additional Funds

Up to \$1,000 a year is available for qualified PROMISE JOBS customers. The money is available to assist you with overcoming challenges to finding or keeping employment such as:

- Interview clothing
- · Work clothing or uniforms
- Tools or equipment
- Car repairs
- Car insurance
- Vehicle registration
- Professional licensing fees
- Relocation expenses
- Utility bills
- Rent for one month

Ask your PROMISE JOBS worker about the Family Self-Sufficiency Grant (FSSG).

#### YOUR FIA RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Your name has been sent to PROMISE JOBS. PROMISE JOBS will help you get the job you need so you can make it on your own. If you need more training or work experience to get off FIP and become selfsufficient, we (with your help) will design your Family Investment Agreement (FIA) so you can get the skills or experience you need. While in a Family Investment Agreement, you will be in one or more of the following PROMISE JOBS activities:

Orientation and Assessment

Unpaid Community Service

Employment

- Family Development
- Work Experience or On-the-Job Training
- Job Seeking Skills and Job Search
- Parenting Skills
- Classroom Training (from basic education to after-high-school education)


#### A. AS A PARTICIPANT IN THE PROMISE JOBS PROGRAM YOU MUST:

- 1. Attend all meetings and give all information requested.
- Call us and tell us before a scheduled meeting if you know you can't be there. If you miss a meeting because you're sick, you may be asked for a doctor's statement.
- If you have problems in your life that make it hard to work with PROMISE JOBS, you must tell
  PROMISE JOBS. Your PROMISE JOBS worker can help you deal with your problems so you
  can get the training and employment you need to get off FIP. The steps to help you with your
  problems can be listed in your Family Investment Agreement.



What happens if I choose not to participate?

Limited Benefit Plan



#### First LBP

- FIP benefits will stop right away
- You can change your mind at any time
- To receive FIP again, you must reapply with HHS & sign a new FIA with PROMISE JOB

#### Subsequent LBP

- FIP benefits stop right away
- You cannot get FIP for at least 6 months
- After the 6-month period, if you want to receive FIP again, you must
  - Reapply with HHS
  - Sign a new FIA with PROMISE JOBS
  - Complete 20 hours of work or other PROMISE JOBS activity



You now have one more opportunity to attend your PROMISE JOBS appointment to develop your Individual Job Search Plan in person on 4/30/2018 at 9:00am at Iowa Workforce Development – 200 Army Post Road, Des Moines, Iowa 50315.

By not attending your PROMISE JOBS appointment, you will have chosen:

- A Limited Benefit Plan (LBP) for the first time.
- Another Limited Benefit Plan (LBP) as you or the other parent in the home have chosen an LBP before. An explanation of the Limited Benefit Plan (LBP) is on the back of this written reminder.

If it is not possible to attend, you must call the above number **<u>BEFORE</u>** the appointment time. You may be asked for proof if you cannot attend.


### Benefits of Cooperation with Child Support Recovery Unit

Tell your PROMINE JOINS worker you want to sign up for FaD94tt

- Notify PROMISE JOBS & HHS immediately upon change of address
- Notify PROMISE JOBS immediately upon starting or ending employment or when a change occurs
- Check your mail & be watchful of notices from PROMISE JOBS
- Email can be a convenient way to communicate. Be sure your PROMISE JOBS worker has your correct email address and check your Email often
- Attend all appointments or activities
  - Call PROMISE JOBS ahead of time if you cannot attend
- Write first & last name on all paperwork
- Turn in all paperwork timely- use your phone calendar to set alerts
- Call before coming to the office, you may not be able to see your PROMISE JOBS Worker without an appointment
- When leaving a voicemail for your PROMISE JOBS Worker, leave **1 phone message** with brief description, full name & phone number
- Set up your voicemail, make sure there is space for messages & check them often
- Ask questions and work WITH your PROMISE JOBS Worker- We are here to help!
